Ms. Brej Gruskin serves as the Intelligence Community Chief Financial Officer (IC CFO). Where she oversees the integration and execution of the National Intelligence Program (NIP) budget and advocates for it before the Office of Management and Budget and Congress. She helps ensure the NIP's affordability, strengthens fiscal accountability, improves execution, and advances sound financial management across the Intelligence Community.

Since joining the Office of the Director of National Intelligence in 2006 on a Joint Duty Assignment with the Office of the IC Chief Information Officer, Ms. Gruskin has held several senior leadership positions spanning mission enterprise and support functions. She previously served as the Deputy Assistant Director of National Intelligence (ADNI) for Acquisition, Procurement, and Facilities (AP&F), leading oversight of the IC acquisitions and Services of Common Concern and supporting a resilient global facilities and logistics enterprise. She also served as Deputy ADNI for Mission Performance, Analysis, and Collection (MPAC), where she oversaw efforts to integrate IC collection and analysis, evaluate mission performance, and advance innovative enterprise capabilities. Earlier, in the Office of the IC CFO, she led resource issue analysis and recommendations affecting multiple IC Elements and cross-program initiatives.

Ms. Gruskin began her career as an Air Force intelligence officer, serving at the Pentagon, U.S. Central Command Air Forces, Kunsan Air Base in South Korea, and multiple deployed locations.

She earned a Master of Public Affairs from Princeton University, a Bachelor of Arts from Purdue University, and a graduate certificate in organizational management from George Washington University.
