The Office of the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community Completes Review of the Intelligence Community Analytic Ombudspersons' Complaint Processes

(March 2022) The Office of the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community (IC IG) completed a review of the Intelligence Community (IC) Analytic Ombudspersons' Complaint Processes in December 2021 (INS-2021-004), pursuant to direction set forth in the classified annex to the Joint Explanatory Statement accompanying the *Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021*. The review determined the effectiveness of the processes IC analytic ombudspersons use to receive, assess, and act on complaints associated with potential political pressure in the analytic production and dissemination processes.

In July 2021, the IC IG provided a memorandum summarizing the results of our review to the congressional intelligence oversight committees. This report details those results and includes one recommendation.
