Dear Ms. DeCell and Mr. Timm:

This is a supplemental response to your Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) request dated October 10, 2017, received in the Information Management Division (IMD) of the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on October 13, 2017.

On July 30, 2018, IMD issued its final response to you, releasing three documents in full and withholding one document in full. Since then, we made a discretionary decision to re-process the document that was originally withheld in full. Accordingly, that document is now being produced to you with redactions pursuant to the following FOIA exemptions:

- b)(1), which applies to information that is currently and properly classified pursuant to Executive Order 13526, Section 1.4 (c);
- (b)(3), which applies to information exempt by statutes; the specific statute applicable to this case is: 50 U.S.C. § 3024 (i)(1), which protects intelligence sources and methods; and,
- (b)(7)(E), which applies to techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions.
