Position Information

This is an opportunity for:

- An internal candidate to fill a GS-15 cadre position.
- A Federal Government employee to serve on a two-year reimbursable detail assignment in the ODNI. The detail assignment may be extended an additional year if all parties agree.

Who May Apply

For a cadre assignment:

- Current ODNI permanent cadre.

For a detailee assignment:

- Current Federal Government employees at the same grade or up to one grade lower than the advertised positions grade may apply.



Salary Determination

- The ODNI uses a rank-in-person system in which rank is attached to the individual. A selected ODNI candidate or other Federal Government candidate will be assigned to the position at the employee's current GS grade and salary.
- A current Federal Government employee, selected for a detail, will be assigned to the position at his or her current grade and salary.

Component Mission

The Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) Chief Operating Officer (COO) has the responsibility for advising the Director of National Intelligence (DNI) and administering the DNI's vision and direction to the ODNI enterprise. This includes synchronizing policy, plans, procedures, and cross-functional issues. The COO is responsible for integrating the ODNI staff to execute all missions and tasks designated by the DNI and the Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence (PDDNI), and for overseeing the internal management of the ODNI.

The COO oversees all ODNI business operations, including such areas as human resources, diversity & inclusion, finance and budget, information technology, security, facilities, and information management. The COO is also responsible for ODNI's emergency planning.

Major Duties and Responsibilities (MDRs)

ODNI HRM is seeking a GS-15 or highly qualified GS-14 to provide leadership and oversight to the ODNI/HRM staffing and resource management functions. This officer will serve as a member of the COO Front Office Chiefs of Staff group, overseeing and managing day-to-day operations for HRM. Duties include:

Lead, manage, and oversee personnel, training, budget, contract administration policies and procedures, as well as, information technology, facilities, equipment, and logistics to foster successful achievement of the organization's mission.

Oversee and facilitate human resources planning and personnel actions within HRM and work closely with HRM leadership to plan, implement, and monitor actions and new HR initiatives.

Oversee budget planning and execution, strategic resource planning, and budget decisions and serve as the primary approving official for the office.

Serve as the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative (COTR) and/or Government Point of Contact responsible for monitoring and evaluating contract deliverables and service level agreements; monitoring contract performance and workload.

Communicate needs and requirements to staff and leadership.

Oversee and manage organizational action processing, standard operating procedures and processes, file maintenance and record-keeping.

Manage and coordinate tasking responses, work activities, assignments, and projects internal to the organization, within the ODNI, and across the IC, ensuring the effective completion of initiatives and requirements.



Work collaboratively with the COO Staff Director and COO Chiefs of Staff to ensure programs and activities are integrated across the COO Component.

Manage and execute internal business management processes for the organization; ensure management and staff are kept abreast of emerging developments.

Mandatory and Educational Requirements

Strategic and tactical planning, critical thinking, and analytical skills in order to propose innovative solutions and implement change with resourcefulness and creativity.

Interpersonal, organizational, and problem-solving skills, including the ability to develop effective working relationships and networks with internal and external stakeholders.

Excellent oral and written communication skills, including the ability to clearly convey complex information to audiences of all levels.

Leadership and managerial skills, including ability to build coalitions within COO and ODNI to achieve common goals.

Superior knowledge of the Government budget process, personnel regulations/systems, policy protocol, and resource allocations.

COTR certification or willingness to earn certification within first six months in the position.

Desired Requirements

Knowledge of missions and functions similar to that of ODNI HRM.

CURRENT FEDERAL EMPLOYEES APPLYING FOR A DETAIL ASSIGNMENT:

Applicants from federal agencies within the Intelligence Community (IC) may be considered for this position as a reimbursable detailee, if endorsed by the employing agency. Applicants must have current TS/SCI clearances with polygraph or have the ability to obtain one. The ODNI does not conduct polygraphs or provide security clearances for detailees.

Applicants from federal agencies outside the IC must provide:

- a. **WRITTEN ENDORSEMENT** from the employing agency concurring with the detail.
- b. **RESUME:** Applicants are encouraged to carefully review the vacancy announcement, particularly the MDRs, and construct their resume to highlight their most significant experience and qualifications relevant to this job opportunity.
- c. **PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS:** Applicants are required to provide their two most recent performance evaluations. A justification is required in the cover letter if the applicant is unable to provide the two most recent evaluations.
- d. **VACANCY NUMBER:** Reference the vacancy number in the subject line of the email and on each document submitted.
- e. **CURRENT SF-50:** Federal Government employees must provide an SF-50, "Notification of Personnel Action" to verify current federal status, position, title, grade, and organization of record. Please disregard if you are not a Federal Government employee.
- f. **COVER LETTER:** Applicants must submit a cover letter as a supplement to the resume to elaborate on their qualifications and previous work performed.
