Position Information

This is an opportunity for:

- An internal or external candidate to fill a GS - 14cadre position.
- A Federal Government employee to serve on a two-year reimbursable detail assignment in the ODNI. The detail assignment may be extended an additional year if all parties agree.

Who May Apply

Current GS employees at the same grade as the advertised position grade may apply.

Former members of the Peace Corps may be considered for ODNI employment only if five full years have elapsed since separation from the Peace Corps.

For a cadre assignment:

- Current ODNI permanent cadre.



- Current Federal Government employees. (Current GS employees at the same grade as the advertised position grade may apply.)
- Candidates outside the Federal Government.
- Current ODNI Staff Reserve employees. (A staff reserve employee who currently occupies this position may not apply.)

For a detailee assignment:

- Current Federal Government employees. (Current GS employees at the same grade as the advertised position grade may apply.)

Salary Determination

- The ODNI uses a rank-in-person system in which rank is attached to the individual. A selected ODNI candidate or other Federal Government candidate will be assigned to the position at the employee's current GS grade and salary.
- A current Federal Government employee, selected for a detail, will be assigned to the position at his or her current grade and salary.
- For a selected non-Federal Government candidate, salary will be established within the salary range listed above, based on education and experience.

Component Mission

The Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) Chief Operating Officer (COO) has the responsibility for advising the Director of National Intelligence (DNI) and administering the DNI's vision and direction to the ODNI enterprise. This includes synchronizing policy, plans, procedures, and cross-functional issues. The COO is responsible for integrating the ODNI staff to execute all missions and tasks designated by the DNI and the Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence (PDDNI), and for overseeing the internal management of the ODNI.

The COO oversees all ODNI business operations, including such areas as human resources, diversity & inclusion, finance and budget, information technology, security, facilities, and information management. The COO is also responsible for ODNI's emergency planning.

Major Duties and Responsibilities (MDRs)

The office of the ODNI Chief Information Officer (CIO) delivers high quality, secure, and cost-effective information and technology enterprise services that advance ODNI strategy, missions, and core business processes in alignment to IC strategic goals.

CIO is seeking a GS-14 COTR to provide leadership and oversight of ODNI-wide Information Technology (IT) projects.

Develop, execute, and communicate spend plans and assess variances from cost and schedule baseline; oversee the reallocation of resources in response to change considering impact to project cost, schedule, and quality of deliverables.



Working with the contractor Program Managers, resolve issues related to the statement of work, customer requirements, project cost, schedules, quality, and performance. Provide expert oversight of cost and resource estimates; participate in budget planning activities and develop cost-estimating strategies for future projects. Work with the CO to manage standard and IDIQ IT contracts.

Supervise the contract deliverables to ensure project is completed on time, effectively apply team building and coaching techniques, and exchange project or technical information with contractor PMs.

Supervise the contract deliverables to ensure counterintelligence and security policies and procedures are followed; provide help or assistance when needed; communicate changing needs and requirements.

Ensure that projects are prioritized in alignment with corporate objectives.

Provide leadership, oversight, and guidance to the effective management of complex projects; manage and mitigate risks, assess customer requirements, identify dependencies, and develop project plans. Ensure plans and schedules are developed and followed throughout the life of the project.

Oversee the contract deliverables, monitoring activities to ensure policies and procedures are proactively followed; provide help or assistance to team members or others when needed; communicate needs and requirements to project managers.

Work closely with mission customers, organizational management, and the CO; direct and coordinate technical and program issues, establish objectives, develop requirements, establish schedules, estimate costs, develop budgetary controls, monitor technical aspects of the contract, and monitor the contract performance; work closely with the CO to assist in contract negotiations, including determining viable options for cost.

Estimate costs and other resources using quantitative analysis to project requirements.

Lead project teams to ensure project is completed on time, effectively apply team building and coaching techniques, and exchange project or technical information with team members and contractors at formal and informal meetings.

Mandatory and Educational Requirements

Extensive experience in providing leadership, oversight, and guidance to the effective management of complex projects; in managing and mitigating risks, assessing customer requirements, identifying dependencies, and developing responsive project plans; in estimating costs and other resources using quantitative analysis to project requirements.

COTR level I is required for this position. Current COTR II certification or the ability to become COTR level II certified within a year is required.

Demonstrated interpersonal, organizational, and problem-solving skills, including a demonstrated ability to work effectively both independently and in a team or collaborative environment and to lead and mentor junior colleagues.

Demonstrated ability to communicate, both verbally and in writing, complex information in a clear, concise manner that is targeted to and meets the needs of diverse audiences with different perspectives and objectives.
