Position Information

This is an opportunity for:

- An internal candidate to fill a SNIS Executive Tier 1 cadre position.
- A Federal Government employee to serve on a two-year reimbursable detail assignment in the ODNI. The detail assignment may be extended an additional year if all parties agree.

Who May Apply

Only Senior Service (SNIS, SES, SIS, DISES, DISL) candidates and highly qualified GS-15s may apply.

Former members of the Peace Corps may be considered for ODNI employment only if five full years have elapsed since separation from the Peace Corps.

- For a detailee assignment:



- Current Federal Government employees. Only Senior Service (SNIS, SES, SIS, DISES, DISL) candidates and highly qualified GS-15s may apply.

Salary Determination

- The ODNI uses a rank-in-person system in which rank is attached to the individual. A selected ODNI candidate or other Federal Government candidate will be assigned to the position at the employee's current GS grade and salary.
- A current Federal Government employee, selected for a detail, will be assigned to the position at his or her current grade and salary.

Component Mission

The Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI), Chief Management Officer (CMO) has the responsibility and authority for supervising, coordinating, providing guidance, and administering the Director of National Intelligence's (DNI) direction to the ODNI, as well as providing guidance to the ODNI centers. This includes integrating and synchronizing policy, plans, positions, procedures, and cross-functional issues. The CMO is responsible for synchronizing and integrating the ODNI staff to execute all missions and tasks designated by the DNI and the Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence (PDDNI). In addition, the CMO oversees the internal management of the ODNI.

- Under the direction of the ADNI, TI, lead and enable an environment that fosters and encourages creative combinations of IC capabilities to deliver the unexpected.
- Under the direction of the ADNI, TI, lead and enable an environment that fosters and encourages the identification, analysis, and red teaming of emerging or future threats.
- Under the direction of the ADNI, TI, lead and enable a culture of innovation across the IC and the ODNI, ensuring that employees have an avenue for providing new ideas for corporate consideration – both technical and non-technical.
- Liaise and collaborate with other components within the directorate, ODNI, IC and USG.
- Lead, direct, and continually refine end-to-end procedures, business practices, and processes for best effect and maximum efficiency.
- Manage, oversee, and justify requirements for T&I personnel, contracts, security, logistics, acquisition, and budget.



- Lead a team of professional staff, assess performance, collaborate and oversee goal setting, and provide feedback on professional development.
- Establish, enable and support a culture of excellence and inclusion.

- a. **WRITTEN ENDORSEMENT** from the employing agency concurring with the detail.
