Most of the rulers did not realize the size of the gap between them and the rising generation. They did not feel the meaning of faith, humanity, dignity, and freedom that mixed with the blood of that generation. So they came from ignorance, because they kept thinking with the mentality of Abu Jahl who thought that his torture of Bilal, Allah be pleased with him, could erase the sweetness of the faith. The only thing he got back from Bilal was him saying "One, One". So if the rulers today know that their attempts are like his attempts, they will know that that they are trying for the impossible, as he who tastes faith and freedom will settle for nothing other than a dignified life.

One of these demands will be that the secretaries of the Council of Trustees will pick up the administration of the country during the transitional period and not the military.

- Warning the leadership that they must change, even after the triumph of the revolution, as these leaderships constitute a risk for them since their psychological make up is susceptible to pressure.

- We ask the leadership that cannot go out in the demonstrations to stay out of the scene and leave the people and their business alone; what happened in Morocco was a terrible mistake.

- [Members of the] leadership who are in their 60s and 70s are ruined because of the repression in that stage; we want young leadership [members who are] in their 40s.
